HALF TERM HOLIDAY

AUTUMN TERM FAMILY STAY AND PLAY CRC Article 31 - All children have the right to play.

Morning and beginning of the week children - 8.50 – 11.05 on Tuesday 15th October.

Afternoon and end of the week children - From the start of your child's Nursery afternoon session until 2.30 on <u>Friday 18th October</u>.

Please come to Nursery and join in with your child as they play and learn. During the sessions you can take the opportunity to chat to the Nursery staff and look together with your child at their Learning Portfolio. If your child attends the Nursery for 30 hours a week, please feel welcome to attend either one of the Stay and Play sessions.

KEY PERSON/PARENTS' EVENINGS

Mrs. Sharp is the Two Year Old Lead within our setting; Mrs Fox is the Key Person for the three and four year olds. As you are aware, we have Stay and Play sessions in which parents can chat informally to their child's Key Person. There will also be an opportunity for all parents of older Nursery children (3 and 4 year olds) to meet with Mrs. Fox after school later this term: <u>week</u> <u>beginning the 21st October</u>. Details about how you can sign up for a formal parents' evening appointment will be sent out later this term.
