2.00- 3.15 (approx. finish) on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July **for afternoon and end of the week children.**

The Nursery will be open for both the am and pm sessions as usual. Children should arrive for their normal starting time and parents, family members and friends are invited to return later to watch our future athletes in action.

**SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES**- Article 29 - All children have the right to be the best that they can be.

The children (Nursery and 2 year olds) should arrive for their normal session time and families can return to school to watch the special assembly and presentations, in the Downstairs Hall in the main building, at the following times...

**SUN PROTECTION**

Article 24 -You have the right to be healthy and to have information to help you stay well.

When the weather becomes warmer we ask that all parents apply waterproof sun block to all children before they come to Nursery. Children that are with us all day will have sun block reapplied after lunch. Please provide us with the sun cream of your choosing, labelled with your child's name. Please do not leave sun cream in your child's Nursery bag. Sunhats are essential as the sun becomes stronger; please name these hats. Please note that we have a few spare hats which we will encourage the children to use as necessary.
