NURSERY ENTERPRISE ACTIVITY – THE BIG TODDLE

The children enjoy playing outside and have told us that they love to look for 'things'. We explained that we were hoping to raise some money by making something or completing a task. Given a choice the children decided that they would love to do a treasure hunt.

When we asked what we could buy with the money raised, the children responded with, "We could have balloons, games and prizes." The children also requested we buy, "A sweet each, a banana or a bit of chocolate, maybe an ice-cream and something to play with."
