You will be aware that, as part of your child's educational experience at Timothy Hackworth Primary School, we aim to promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive taught programme of Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education that gives children and young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live healthy, safe, productive and fulfilled lives, both now and in the future. Relationships and Health Education is becoming a statutory subject in September 2020.
