

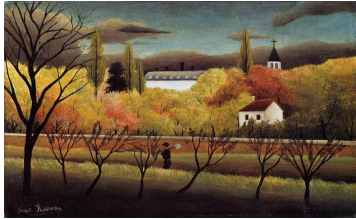
# Year 1: A Sense of Place.

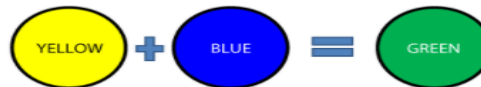
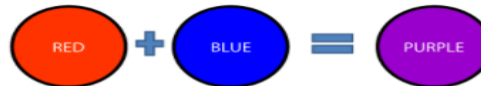

control	Taking your time and making things neat.
darkening	To make something darker.
differences	Things that are not the same.
expression	To show thoughts and feelings.
landscape	An area of land that you can see.
lightening	To make something lighter or paler.
predict	To say what might happen.
primary colours	The basic colours: red, yellow and blue.
secondary colours	Colours made from primary colours: purple, green and orange.
similarities	Things that are the same.
