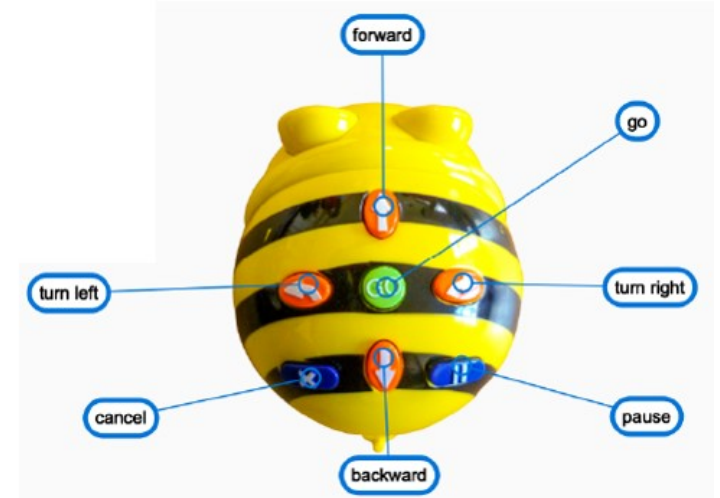
## Physical Algorithms

Meet **Bee-Bot!** Bee-Bot is a floor robot that you can control!

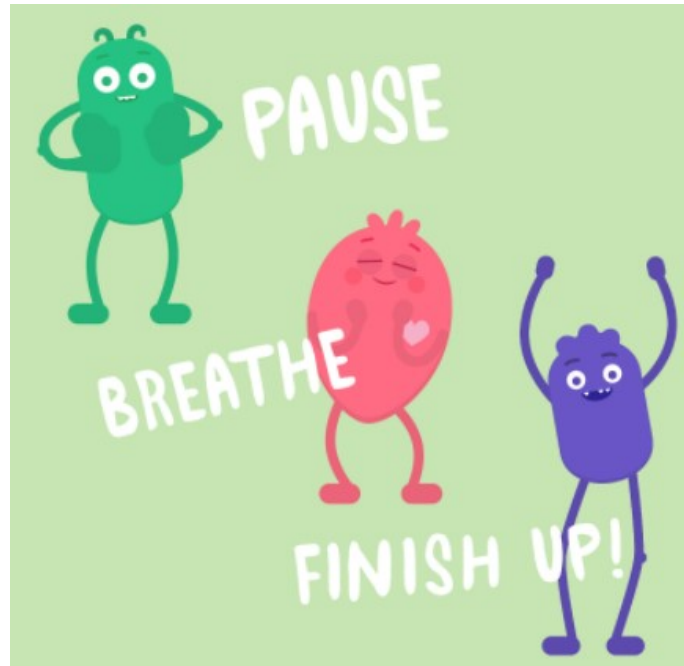
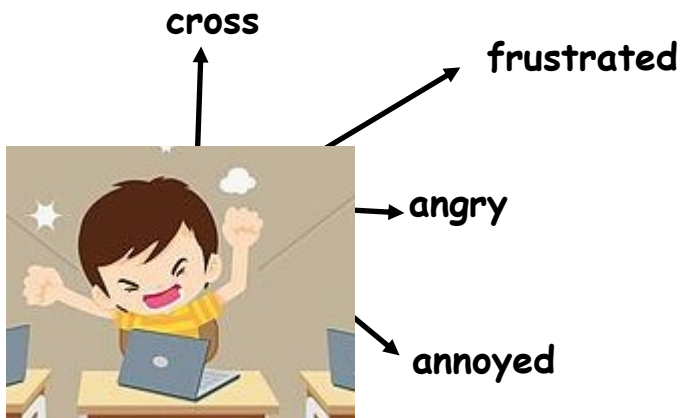
You can write an **algorithm** for Bee-Bot to follow. Remember, an **algorithm** is a simple set of instructions.

## Vocabulary

algorithm	A set of instructions.
arrows	A shape that tells you which way to go.
backwards	To go towards the back.
Bee-Bot	A floor robot.
breathe	Take air into the body and send it out again.
command	An order, telling someone or something what to do.
debug	To fix what is wrong.
device	A phone, tablet or PC.
finish up	Turn off your device.
forwards	To go towards the front.
frustrated	Feeling very annoyed or angry.
pause	Stop doing something.
program	A set of instructions for a robot or computer to carry out.
