

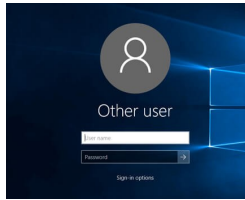
# Year 2: Computing and Online Safety

## Keyboard and mouse skills

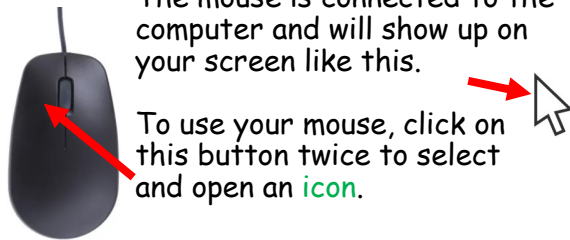


To turn your laptop on, you need to press the **on** button.

Log on with your first initial and surname. For example: Bob Smith = bsmith

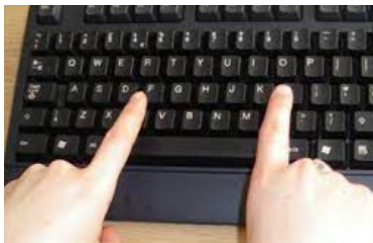


To use a **mouse**, you need to use your full hand.

Try to use your two index fingers to type on your keyboard.

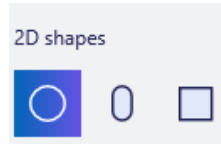
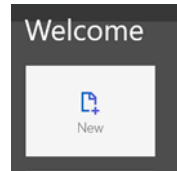

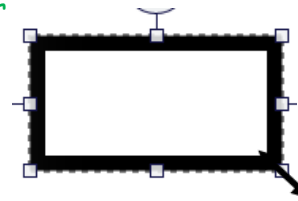
## Multi-media

Open **Microsoft Paint 3D**. Choose a new document.

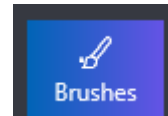


Choose a **shape** that you want and drag it to the right size.

Make a shape **bigger** or **smaller** by dragging the corner.



To colour the shape select the **brushes** tab.



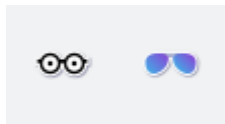
Select the **fill** button.



You can add a **solid** colour



or change the **effects** by adding stickers.

Click on the **text** tab and click where you want to write.

Drag and draw a text box and add your text.
