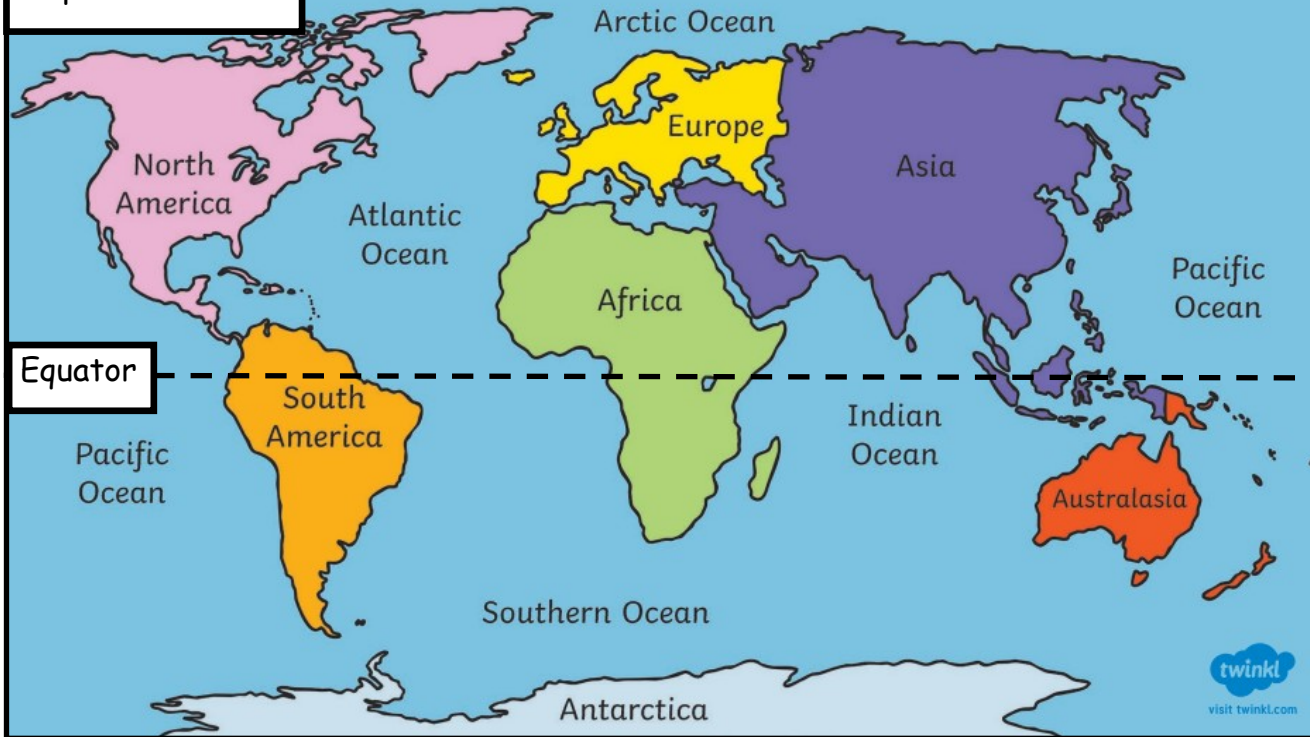

weather	rain, wind, snow, sun, storms, clouds

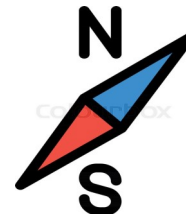
wildlife	Animals and insects that live without human help.
