

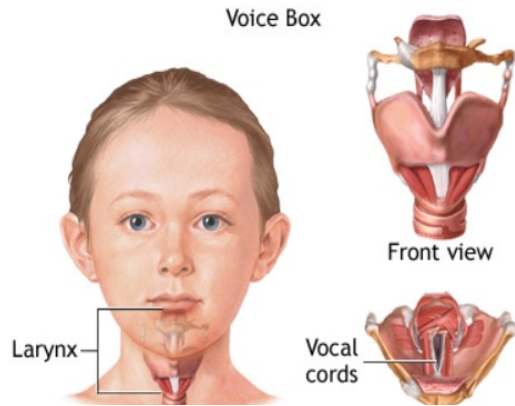
# Year 1: Music

This unit is about using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

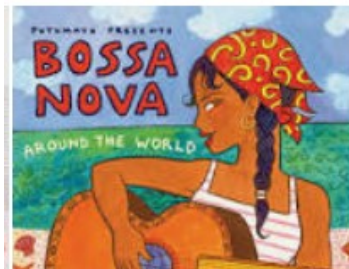
**We can use our voices to create different effects.**
