

- By the early 1980s, the promotion of Pop music had been greatly affected by the rise of music television channels like MTV;
- The lyrics of Pop songs typically focus on themes like love and romantic relationships;
- A lot of Pop music is designed to encourage dancing.



Bob Dylan is an American singer and songwriter. He has written more than 500 songs that have been recorded by more than 2,000 artists. In 2016 Dylan became the first musician to win the **Nobel Prize** for Literature.

ballad	A song set to a slow tempo that deals with the themes of love and loss.
cover	A different musician's version of a song.
interlude	A musical composition inserted between the parts of a longer composition.
strings	Strings are lengths of a flexible material that a musical instrument holds under tension so that they can vibrate freely, but controllably.
tag ending	A tag generally occurs at the end of a section, or at the end of the tune, and usually isn't longer than a few bars.
