## Year 3: How and why is Advent important to Christians?

## What is Advent?

**Advent** is an important part of the Christian calendar.

It means 'coming' and it's the period before Christmas, which celebrates the birth of Jesus.

It is all about preparing for Christmas Day.

Advent starts on the Sunday nearest to the 30th of November.

Some ways that Christians prepare during Advent:

- · Churches are decorated in purple. Purple is colour for Lent and Advent because it is seen as a solemn colour and the colour for God
- Passages are read from the Bible about Mary being visited by the Angel and the birth story.
- · Advent services take place from the first Sunday in Advent.
- · Carols are sung.
- · Collections for particular charities take place.
- · There is Carol singing within the community.
- · There are Carol Services on the Sunday before Christmas.
