amphibian	Amphibians have wet skin. As young they live in water and as they grow they live on land.
bird	A bird's body is covered in feathers. It has wings. It lays eggs.
carnivore	An animal that only eats meat.
fish	Its body is covered in scales. It uses gills to breathe.
herbivore	An animal that only eats plants.
invertebrate	An animal without a backbone.
mammal	Its body is covered in skin. It can grow hair or fur. The baby drinks its mother's milk.
omnivore	An animal that eats plants and meat.
reptile	Its body is covered in scales.
vertebrate	An animal with a backbone.
zoologist	A scientist who is an expert in animals.
