





# Gold Level Rights Respecting School


Article 19: All children have the right to be safe.

Article 17: All children have the right to information as long as it is not harmful.

## For my own personal safety - everywhere!

- I will ask permission from a member of staff before using the internet at school.
- I am aware of "stranger danger" when on-line.
- I will tell an adult about anything online which makes me feel uncomfortable.
- I will not try to bypass the system to reach websites the school has blocked.
- I understand that the school may check my files and may monitor the web pages that I visit.
- When in school I will only contact people with my teacher's permission.





 I will not put my "Personal Information" online. (My full name, birthday, phone number, address, postcode, school etc.)



## To keep the system safe:

- I will only use my own log-in and password, which I will keep secret.
- All children have a right to privacy so I will not access other people's files.
- I will not play games on a device unless my teacher has given me permission.
- I will not install software on school devices.
- I will not use the system for gaming, gambling, shopping, or uploading videos or music.



# My responsibility to others:

- The messages I send will be polite and respectful.
- I will not upload images or videos at home of other people without their permission.
- Where work is copyrighted (including music, videos and images) I will not download or share these with others.
- I understand that the school may take action against me if I am involved in incidents of inappropriate behaviour wherever their location.
   If the activities are illegal this may be reported to the police.



#### Personal Devices

- Personal devices should **not** be brought into school.
- The school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to personal devices.
- It is not permitted for pupils to have mobile phones or smart watches during the school day.
- If it is essential to bring a mobile phone to school, a letter from parents/carers is required, and the phone must be handed in to the office on arrival at school and collected on the way out of school.

### Conditions of School Use
