Personal information includes:

- your full **name**;
- your **address**;
- your **school** name;
- information about your **family**;
- any **passwords** that you might have.

This could be your parents, carers or your teachers.

bar chart	A chart with different sized bars to compare your data.
block graph	A simple chart which shows data with blocks.
chart	A way to show and display information visually.
data	A collection of facts or information.
information	Facts about someone or something.
j2e	A computing program.
password	A secret word or phrase used to log in to programs.
personal	Belongs to you.
private	Information that is secret.
represent	Shows or illustrates.
security	Being free and safe from danger.
trusted adult	A grown up that you can talk to.
