

# Year 3: Computing and Online Safety

## Multimedia - Using Publishing Software

**Microsoft Publisher** is a computing program that is used for **desktop publishing**.

You will be **publishing** a poster, just like the one below, by adding titles, pictures and text to a page. You will need to use the **copy** and **paste** function to paste pictures from the **Internet**.

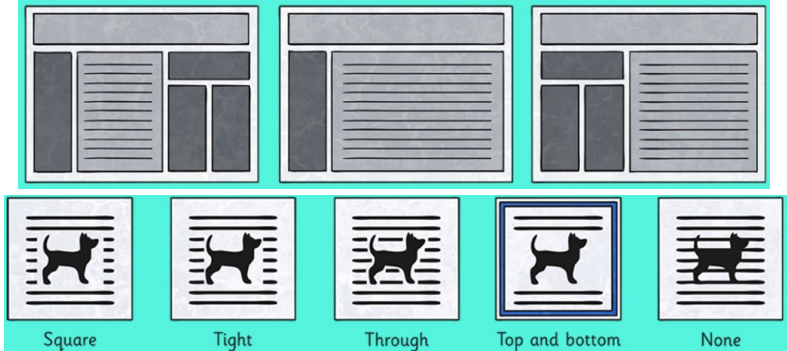
You can then format your work by **moving**, **resizing** and **cropping** the images that you've found.

Finally, you will learn to add **text boxes** and change the **background colour** of your poster to make it stand out.



### How to publish a perfect poster:

1. Click **Microsoft Publisher**.
2. Add a suitable title using **WordArt**.
3. Insert pictures from the Internet by **copying and pasting**.
4. Insert **text boxes** and type to add text.
5. Edit by moving the text and images around until you are happy. Add a **background colour**.
6. **Save** your perfectly published poster!



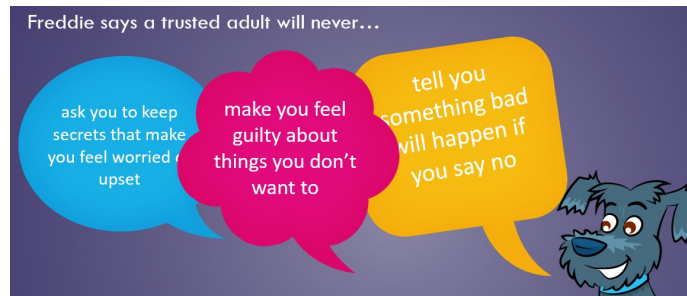
## Vocabulary

background colour	The colour behind text and images.
copy	To make an identical version of something.
crop	To remove unwanted portions of an image.
Microsoft Publisher	A desktop publishing program used to present multi-media on one page.
paste	Places an object onto your page.
personal information	Information that belongs to you and is shared with trusted people only.
publish	To create documents that are ready to be printed.
resize	To make the object smaller or bigger.
save	To keep the document for later.
text box	A box that allows you to type text.
trusted adult	A grown up that you can confide in.
WordArt	A gallery of text styles that can be used in titles.
