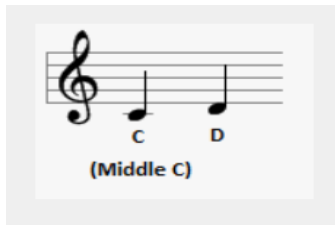
Your Imagination

This unit is about using your imagination.

- *A Whole New World*, from Aladdin.

You will be using the notes C and D.



Here is the introduction for Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious. It tells us on the score it is 120 beats per minute. In Italian the musical term for this tempo is **Allegro Moderato**. This means fairly quickly. We can use a **metronome** to help us keep a steady tempo.



Vocabulary

combine	To join or merge together.
melody	A type of tune.
metronome	A device that keeps a steady beat.
Pop music	Modern music that started in the 1950s.
repeat	To say or do the same thing again.
rhythmic	Music's pattern in time.
tempo	Speed or pace.
tuned	Adjust (a musical instrument) to the correct pitch.
