## <u>Using a Metronome</u>


A metronome is used:

- to make sure that you are playing at a steady tempo;
- as a recording tool to make sure a performance is metrically precise.

Metronomes used for recording are often called a "click track". They are extremely popular in the recording of film scores where the music must sync to individual frames of film.
