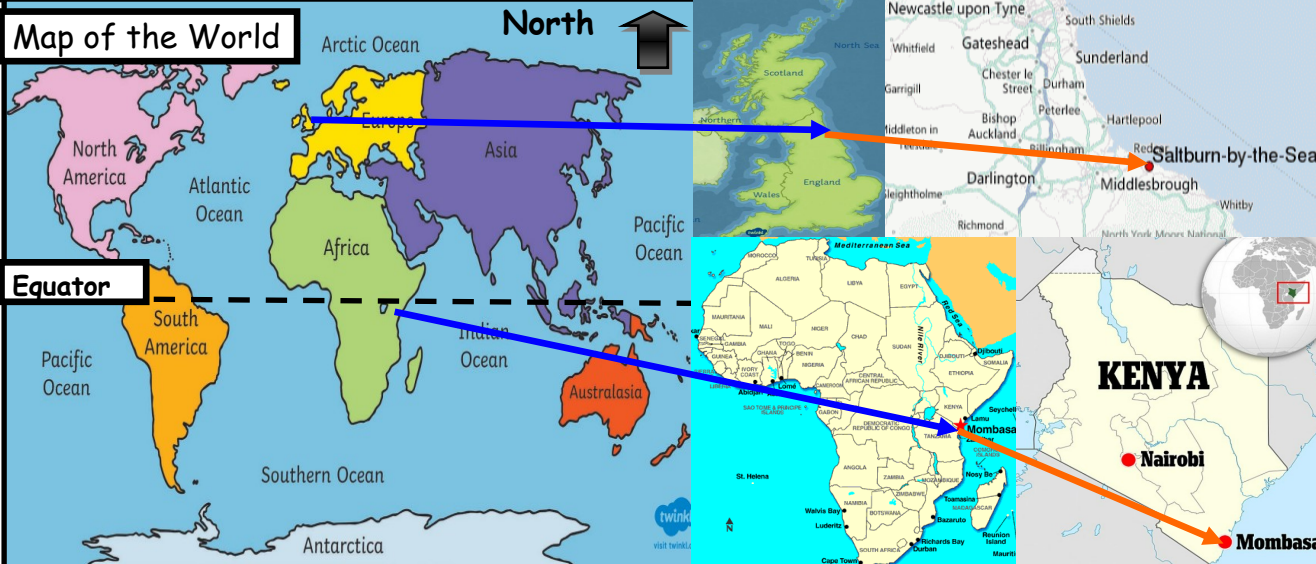


# Year 2: What might we see on holiday?

sea	A smaller part of an ocean.
station	A place on a railway where trains stop so passengers can get on and off.
symbol	A little picture instead of a word on a map.
temperature	How hot or cold something is.
trade	The action of buying and selling goods and services.
valley	The low land between two hills.
vegetation	Plants found in an area.
