Physical Algorithms

Scratch Junior is a coding programme that allows you to create your own interactive stories and games!

You will be snapping together graphical programming blocks to make characters move, jump, dance and sing.

You can also modify the characters in the **paint editor**, add your own voices and sounds, and **insert photos** to help you to make your **character** come to life.

In Computing lessons, you will be accessing the following adventure programs:

- Drive Across the City
- Run a Race
- Dance Party
- Meet and Greet

While creating algorithms and debugging when you come across any issues, you will be able to pick backgrounds and characters and use motion blocks to speed up, slow down and stop characters. As you progress, you will be able to make the characters dance and even send messages to each other!
