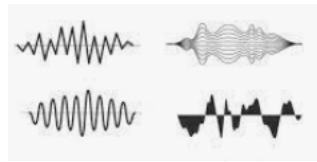
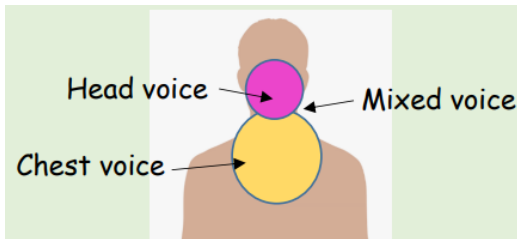
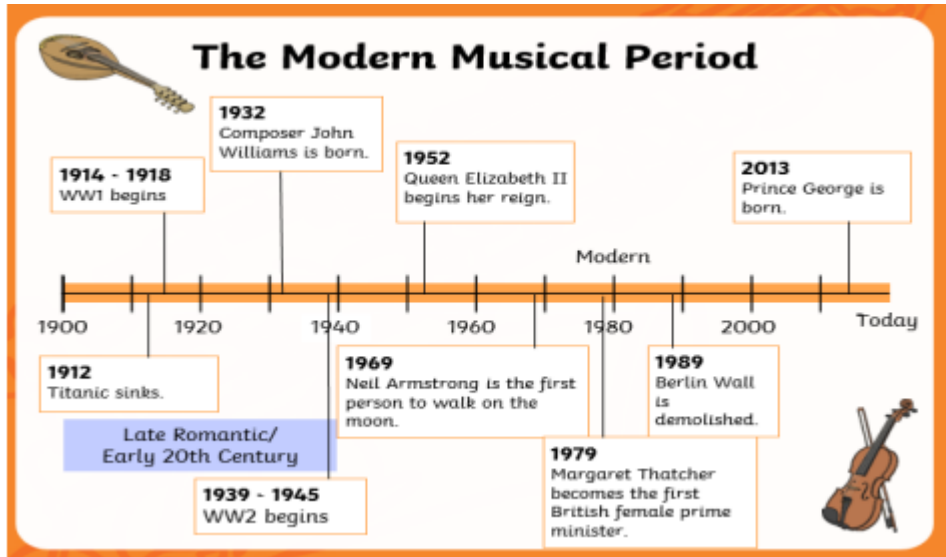

Soundscapes

Vocabulary

loop	A loop is a short, repeated section of music. This is a melody, or rhythm, that plays continuously throughout the song.
manipulate	Creating the perfect mashup with two different tunes.
sample	Using a portion of an existing song in a brand new recording.
soundscape	An acoustic environment.
source	Direct representation of the work of the composer.
