## Belonging to a Community

A community is a group of people living, working, worshipping or socialising together.

We all belong to different communities. It could be your family, your school, clubs you attend, or your religious community.



We all have a role to play in our school and in the wider community. We are all important! Everyone has a right to be included!

You can help people to feel included by:

- respecting others;
- · caring for vulnerable people;
- treating everyone equally;
- giving extra help to those who might need it;
- being kind, friendly and positive.

## Money and Work

We need money to pay for things that we want to buy. We can use **cash** or a **debit** card.





People are paid for the jobs that they do. The money they are paid is called an 'income'.

People need to buy essential things. Once they have bought these things, they need to decide whether to **spend** or **save** their leftover money.

### Wants and Needs

**Need** - A <u>need</u> is something that is essential in order to live. It is necessary for survival.

Want - A want is something that you would like to have but you could live without it.



Needs are our rights!

### **Transition**
