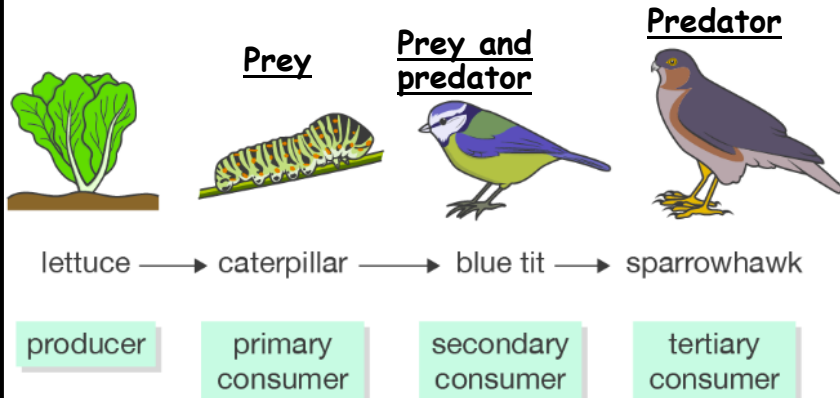


# Year 4: The science behind a right-holder's right to be healthy.

### Producer

### Consumer

This is an animal that eats a plant or animal to gain energy.

### Predator

An animal that hunts and eats another animal.

### Prey

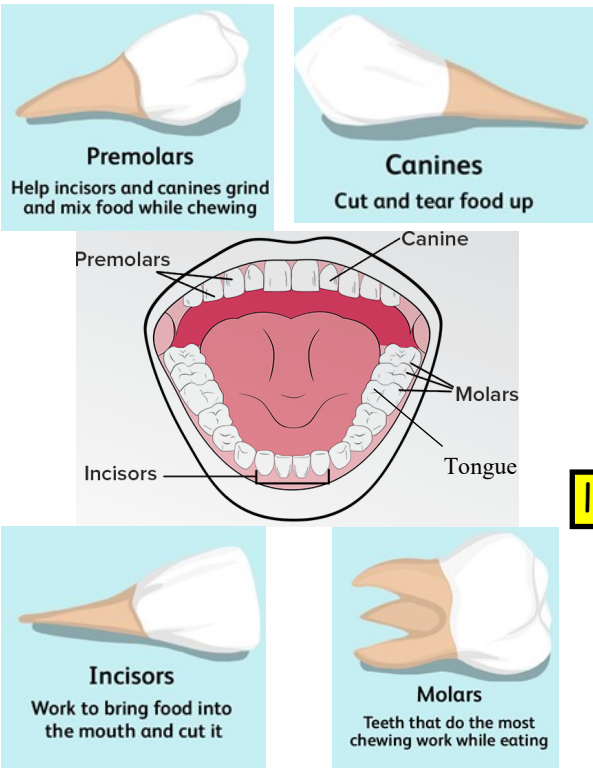
An animal that is hunted and killed for food by another animal.

## Vocabulary

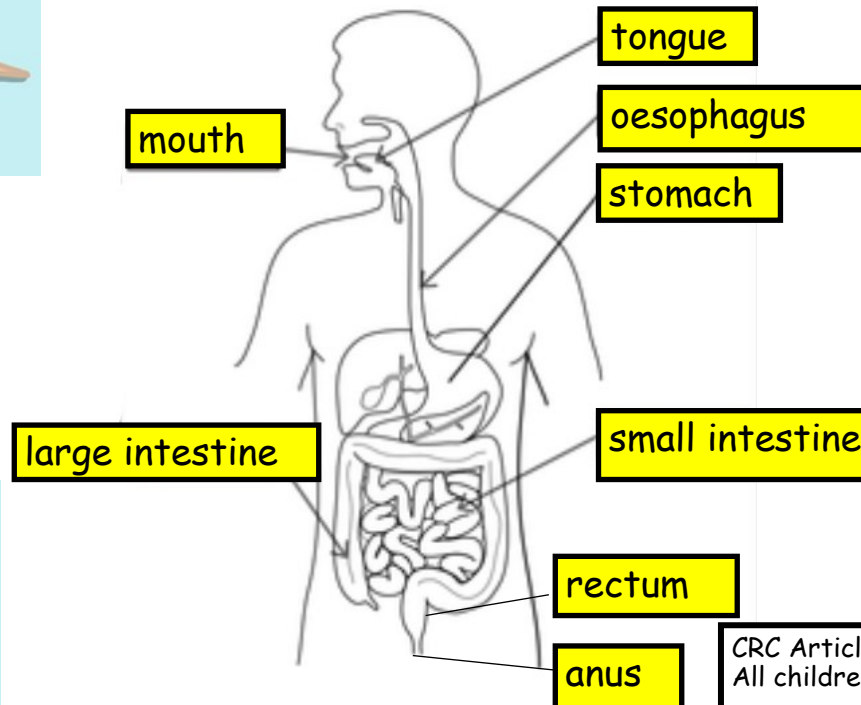
anus	The opening where solid waste (faeces/poo) leaves the body.
carnivore	An animal with a meat only diet.
dental health	Taking care of your teeth and gums.
digestion	The process where your body breaks food down into the nutrients it needs.
floss	A thread which cleans between the teeth.
herbivore	An animal with a plant only diet.
large intestine	The lower part of the intestine that removes water from digested food.
oesophagus	The tube where food moves from the mouth to the stomach.
omnivore	An animal with a plant and meat diet.
oral hygiene	Keeping your mouth clean through brushing, mouth wash, flossing and regular dental check ups.
rectum	The lowest part of the bowel.
saliva	Liquid produced by the mouth.
small intestine	Nutrients are absorbed here.
stomach	An organ that helps to break down food.
