Duke Ellington

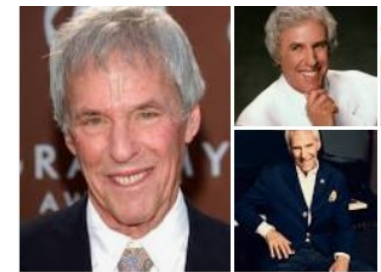
