





Introduction

At Timothy Hackworth Primary School, the views of our parents and carers, including about our SEND provision, are extremely important to us. We actively seek these views by sending out an annual SEND Parents and Carers Questionnaire. The results of the SEND Questionnaire tell us what is working well, about areas we can develop further and, importantly, help to shape future SEND provision across the school.
