How does Fairtrade help?



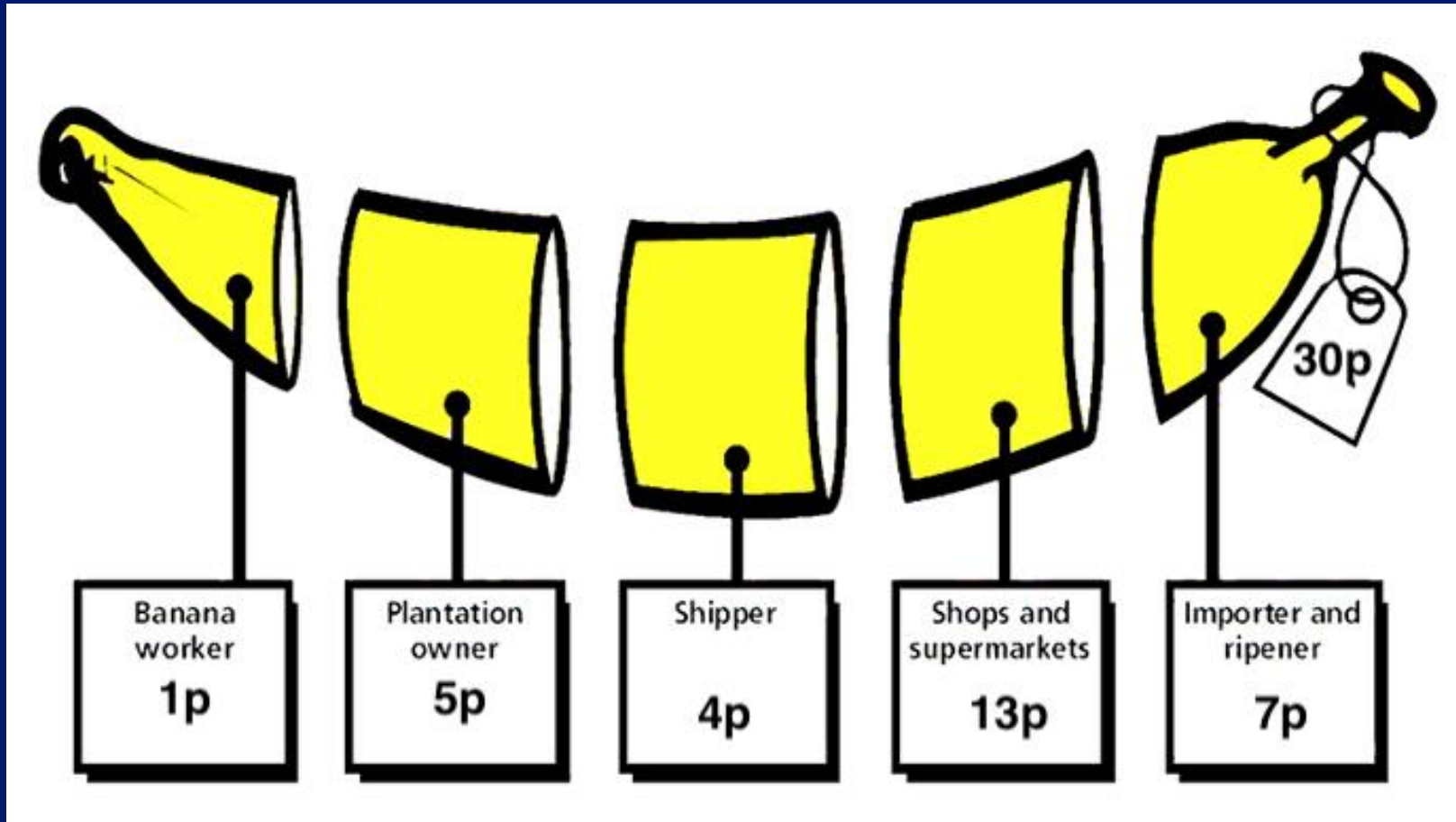
Buying Fairtrade gives higher wages for farmers, who can take positive steps to tackle climate change.
