Grammar - The phoneme 'e'	Grammar - Acute Accent 'é'	Language Learning Skills	Language Learning Skills	Language Learning Skills
The phoneme 'e' can be represented by the graphemes 'é', 'er' and 'ez'. e.g. <i>café, regarder, Regardez !</i>	This accent appears only over the letter 'e'. It changes the pronunciation of the letter 'e'. In English words that have been borrowed from French, the acute accent can still be found, e.g. <i>Café</i> .	Recall vocabulary by identifying images. Practise reading aloud by listening to a model, and focusing on pronunciation and intonation.	Memorise vocabulary when memorising new words or sentences. Gradually remove the text and recall it with the help of images. Engage in conversations. Use familiar questions and answers.	Spelling. Try to remember spellings by hiding the word, then trying to spell or write them from memory. Descriptions. Use familiar vocabulary and sentence structures to give a spoken description and a written description of a place.
