- Nowadays, many people give chocolate eggs to their friends and family to celebrate Easter.

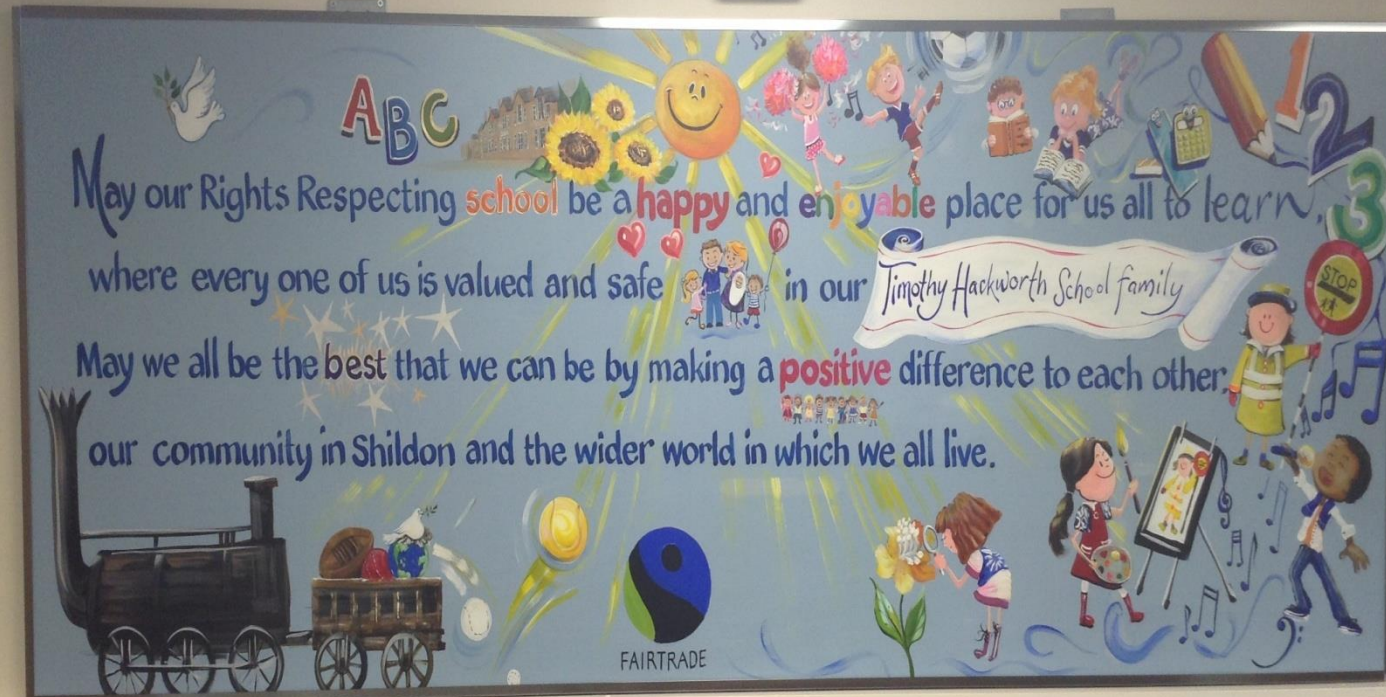
