We are pleased to inform you of the arrangements for the Year 6 Leavers' Party to celebrate your child's time at Timothy Hackworth Primary School, before moving on to pastures new into Year 7.

The party will be held for the Year 6 children on Monday 14th July, 6.00 – 8.00 pm, at Shildon Civic Hall.

Tickets are required for this event. There is a maximum of 3 tickets per family which includes one free ticket for your child. The cost of the tickets for family members is £3.00 each which includes either hot dog and chips or beef burger and chips. Juice will also be provided for the children and additional drinks can be purchased at the bar. Please complete the Microsoft Forms which you will receive by a text link to indicate your attendance and meal choice by Friday 27th June so that food orders can be placed. Please also pay for your family member tickets via Parent Pay by Friday 27th June.

The capacity of the Civic Hall means that only two family members, at a maximum, are able to accompany your child to the party. We respectfully ask that younger siblings do not attend this event due to capacity limits.

Please note that a parent or carer is required to accompany their child to the party.

We look forward to seeing you at our Year 6 Leavers' Assembly on Friday 18th July at 9.30 a.m. Due to our limited Hall space, we kindly ask for two family members at a maximum to attend. Year 6 children can leave school with their parents after the Year 6 Leavers' Assembly, should parents and carers wish for this to happen. Alternatively, if parents would like children to remain in school until the end of the day, we would be delighted for your child to stay and spend their last afternoon in Year 6 with us!
